SECURE PASSPHRASES ARE...

A COMBINATION OF:

- ✓ Numbers
- ✓ Upper and lowercase letters
- ✓ Symbols
- ✓ Over 8 characters in length

NOT A WORD:

- ✗ Not your footy team
- ✗ Not your pet's name
- ✗ Not your birthday month
- ✗ Not a sequence or pattern
